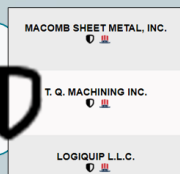
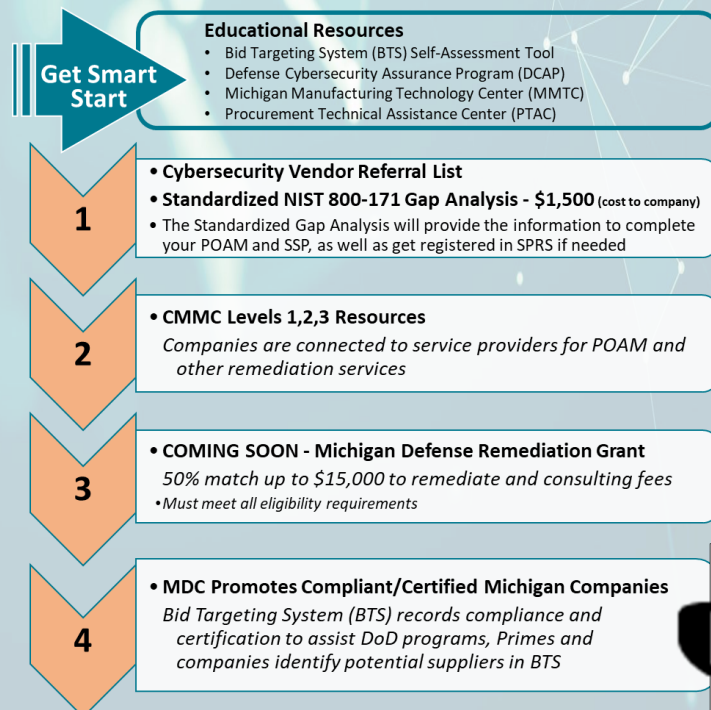

## Overview of CyberSmart Program & Phases 1-4

Whether you hold the contract yourself, or you've been subcontracted to make a specific part, you need to meet an appropriate level of the Cybersecurity Maturity Model Certification (CMMC) if you want to retain your contract and bid on future contracts.

The Michigan Economic Development Corporation's (MEDC) Michigan Defense Center (MDC) has identified Michigan contractors to provide cybersecurity consulting services for small and medium-sized Michigan businesses to assist with the implementation of the requirements in National Institute of Standards and Technology Special Publication (NIST SP) 800-171 required for achieving DFARS 252.204-7012 compliancy, as well as CMMC direction in order to qualify for United States Departments of Defense (DoD) and Homeland Security (DHS) contracts and work in the federal supply chain.



This program is not focused on providing customizable services for developing Plans of Action and Milestones (POA&M) or remediation action plans, policies and procedures, implementation plans, systems security plans, incident response plans, remediation, and managed services. Michigan businesses will be referred to MDC partners that currently provide these services, or businesses can choose to work with vendors providing services or the MDC prequalified vendors list.
